Accommodation: You can stay at the oncampus hotel, the POSCO International Center, or in Young-il-dae Hotel which is in 20 min. of walking distance from the department. For reservation, please notify us of your schedule in advance.

**Visa**: Korea has agreements with over 160 countries for no-visa entry. When uncertain as to the requirement for entry visa to Korea, please contact the Korean embassy or a consulate as early as possible. In some cases, a visitor may be required to present an invitation letter from POSTECH to the Korean consulate. In such a case, request a letter from the person you are in contact with or the Mathematics department office.

**Accessibility:** Over 3,700 international flights from 165 cities worldwide on 272 routes arrive in Korea every week. And over 2,600 domestic flights on 18 routes connect Seoul with 13 cities every week.

**Korean Currency**: Korea's official monetary unit is the won (KRW). The Korean currency consists of a fifty thousand, ten thousand, five thousand, and one thousand won note, and five hundred, one hundred, fifty and ten won coins.

**Electricity**: In Korea, electrical outlets are operated at 220 volt only.


# How to get to POSTECH after arriving in Korea Incheon Int'l Airport (Seoul)

- 1. By domestic flight: Take Airport Limousine Bus or Airport Express Train to Gimpo airport (30 min) - Domestic flight to Pohang (50 min) → Taxi to POSTECH (20 min)
- 2. By train: Take Airport Express Train to Seoul station (43 min) → KTX train to Singyeongju Station (2h) → Limousine bus to Pohang bus terminal (35 min) → Taxi to POSTECH (10min)
- 3. By bus: Take the Limousine Bus at platform 10c to Pohang bus terminal (5.5h). Bus Schedule: 07:00 08:50 13:40 17:10 19:30 21:30 → Taxi to POSTECH (10min).



## Gimhae Int'l Airport (Busan)

Take Airport Limousine Bus to Pohang bus terminal (1.7h) → Taxi to POSTECH (10min.)

Business Hours & Holidays: The regular office hours of administrative service are from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. The office is closed on weekends, Korean national holidays and POSTECH anniversary day (Dec. 3rd).

Access to POSTECH Buildings: Visitors need building entry cards to gain access to POSTECH buildings. You will get a card at the Mathematics office, Room 302 (#3). Please, return the card when you leave POSTECH.

**Dining:** Korean Restaurant, Yeon-ji, and Burger King are located on in the Jigok Community Center (#60). Student cafeteria is located in the Student Union Building (#13). You may also want to try the fusion style restaurant, D' Medley or the Chinese restaurant, Phoenix, located in the POSCO International center (#62).

Phone Services: To call a POSTECH number, just dial the 7 digit number of the person you wish to contact. To make off-campus calls, please dial 9 followed by the area code or mobile service provider code, then the phone number.

Mails: Outgoing mails are handled by the campus mail center on the B1st floor of the POSTECH Science building I (#2). Dept staff can help you with sending out mails.

Print, Copy and Fax: You can make black and white photo copies in Room 303 during business hours. You can also use the copy machine as a printer. The PCs in Visiting Professor's rooms are installed with the necessary drivers. If you wish to fax a document, a staff member in the office will assist you.

**Internet Access**: All PCs in Math dept offices have internet access. Free wireless internet is available in most parts of the Mathematical Science Building.

First Aid: POSTECH runs a free-of-charge on-campus clinic located on the 2nd floor of the Student Union Building (#13).

**Banking**: There is a Woori Bank branch office on the first floor of the Student Union Building (#13). In addition, ATMs for Woori Bank and Kookmin Bank are available on the 1st floor of Administration Building (#1).
